How to get there

- by Car¹:

A3 exit Raunheim, "Raunheim/Ortsdurchfahrt", turn right 2000m after town sign into Moselstr. - the Hotel is signposted.

- by Train:

Take train to Frankfurt Airport and shuttle bus from there (Departures see below). Or: S-Bahn station Raunheim (S8,S9), ca. 1 km from Hotel. S-Bahn leaves Frankfurt Main Station track 103 every 15 minutes (:01 :16 :31 :46), arrives 22 minutes later.

- by Plane²:

Take shuttle bus from Frankfurt Airport Terminal 1, Arrival Hall A, Exit 1. Large Shuttle Bus is labelled with "Wings Shuttle". Bus takes about 25 min.
